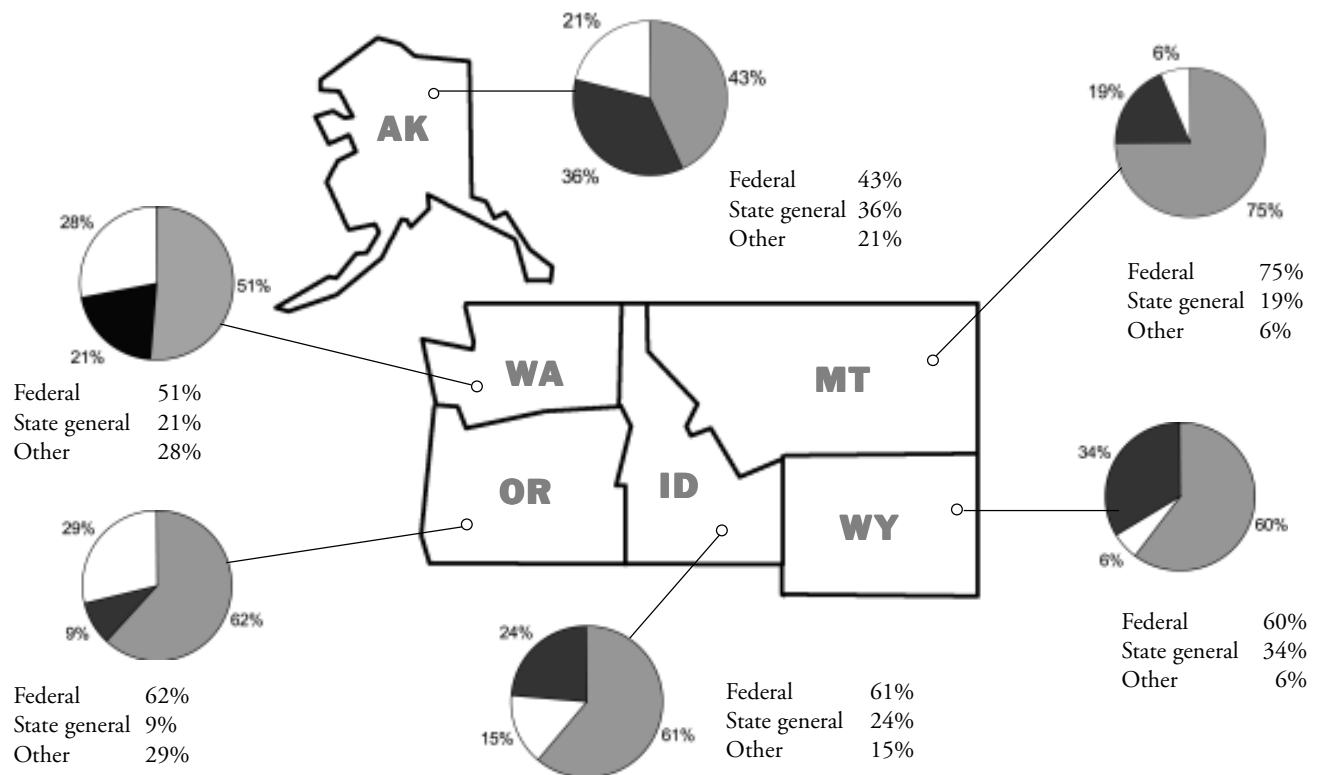


# Northwest Region at a Glance
